11. O. CAMANCHICA, E. & B. in P. R. R.: prostrata; articulis adscendentibus majusculis suborbiculatis; pulvillis remotis plerisque armatis; setis stramineis fulvisve parcis; aculeis 1-3 compressis fuscis apice pallidioribus, superioribus elongatis suberectis, caeteris deflexis; bacca ovata late umbilicata; seminibus majusculis angulatis hilo excisis.

Llano Estacado, on the Upper Canadian River. A large, extensively spreading plant; the joints 6-7 inches long; spines 1½-2 or even 3 inches long. Fruit large, juicy. Seeds 2-3 lines in diameter, very irregular and deeply notched at the hilum.
